How Do I Join?

Joining is easy! Fill in the membership form & drop in during opening times to join up as a member. Toy Library is located at the rear of the Beechworth Neighbourhood Centre, Cnr. Ford & Church Sts.

How Much Does It Cost?

BTL closes for stock take the week before Christmas and reopens during the middle of January.

Overdue, Broken or Damaged Toys, Lost Pieces

Overdue toys will incur a fine. Broken or damaged toys are payable 50% of the depreciated value as assessed by the committee. Lost pieces are payable \$2 per piece, refundable on return of the piece. There is a ceiling of \$10 on unpaid fines. Once a member owes \$10 or greater, their borrowing rights will be suspended. Fines must be paid in full before resumption of borrowing rights.

What Can I Borrow?

We have a wide range of educational, non-violent toys for a range of ages from 0 to early primary years. Categories of toys include water play, transport, large outdoor toys, games, puzzles, role play, construction, costumes, party packs. BTL also has a range of books and tapes covering topics such as birthday cakes, games to play with children, costumes, etc.

Members are able to borrow 2 toys per child and reference books.

General Information

- Members are **not** required to undertake duty as part of their membership however they are welcome to come in and help out at any time.
- Toys are to be returned in a clean condition — i.e. wiped down.
- Members are required to count pieces of toys at the BTL when borrowing and returning toys.
- Any damage or lost pieces are to be reported when toys are returned.
- All members are asked to help raise funds at least twice a year — cake stall kiosk and raffle (Sat. of Mother's Day weekend) & Bunnings Sausage Sizzle Stall. We also have a toy catalogue fundraiser in September and encourage members to swipe BTL Community Benefit Cards at Richies Supermarket.

Newsletters & Duty Roster

A newsletter with information on new toys, fundraising activities, roster reminder, general meeting dates, committee members' names and phone numbers and other information is given to all members. You can have this delivered via email or collect your copy when next at the toy library. The newsletter and roster are produced each school term. There is also a newsletter and roster posted on the notice board at the Toy Library.

Helping at Toy Library

Any help is greatly appreciated by the committee members

- Take BTL sign out to the front of BNC and bring back in at end of opening time.
- Tidy toy library.
- Support committee member by checking toys returned — no. of pieces and condition.

Temporary Membership

This membership is designed for short term use, for example grandparents and family members over the school holiday periods. The borrowing period is for up to 2 weeks. Membership fee is \$10 with a refundable bond of \$30. Two (2) toys can be borrowed at a time, with a fee of \$5 for each additional toy borrowed.

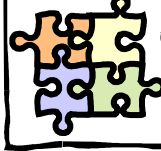
